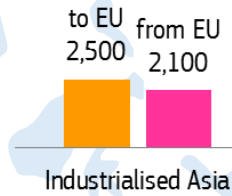
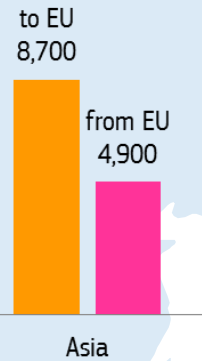
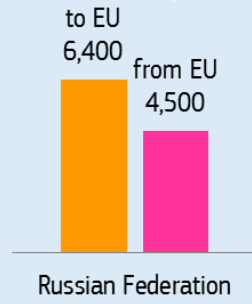
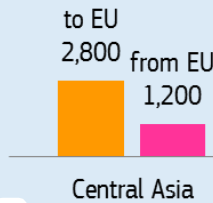
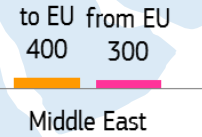
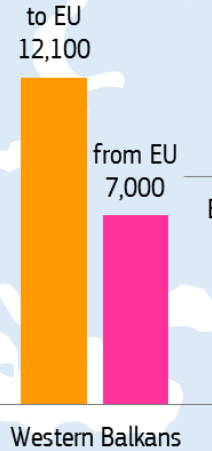
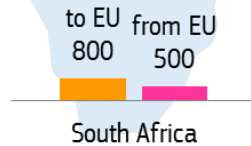
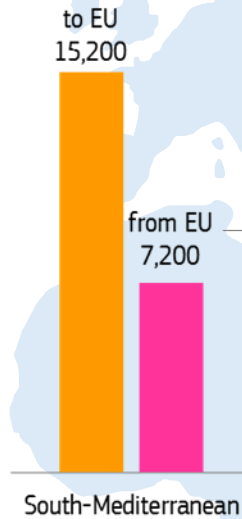
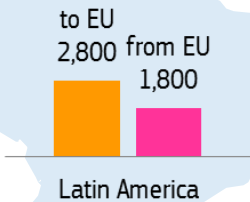
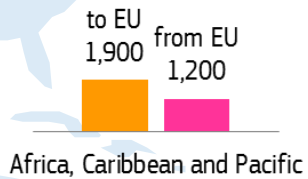
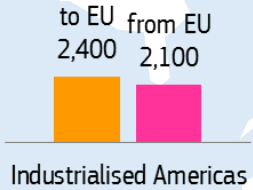


International credit mobility budget 2018 (tbc)

100,000 exchanges planned since 2015, and counting...



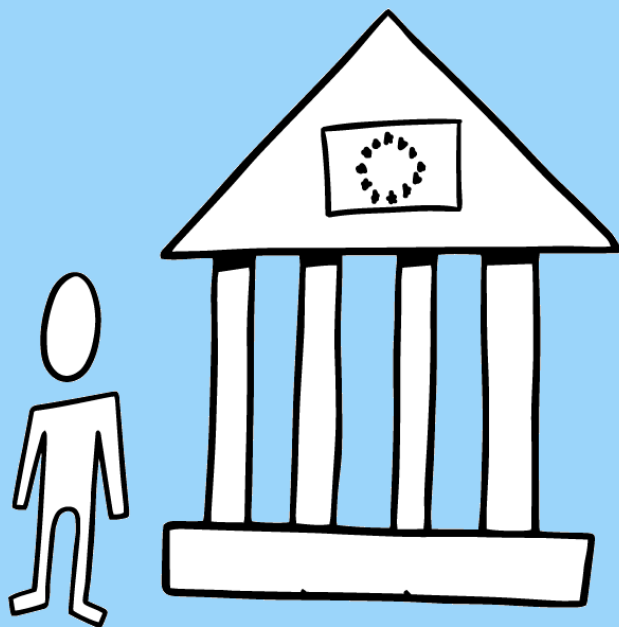

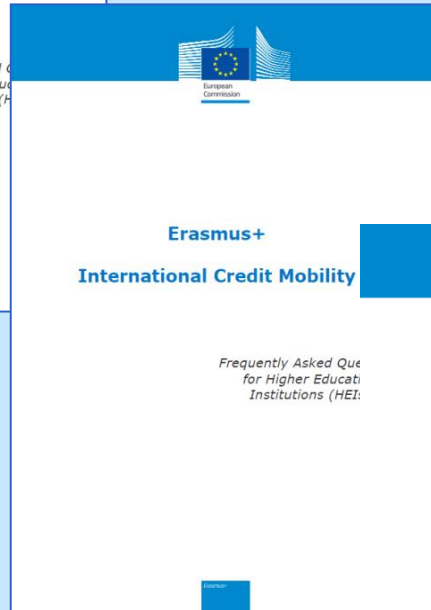
International Credit Mobility Timeline for Contractual Documents

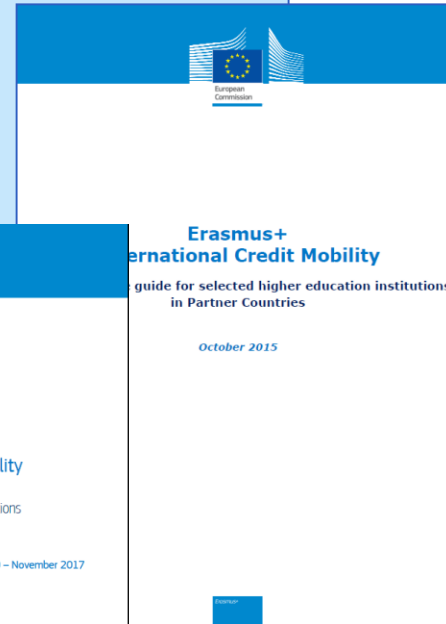

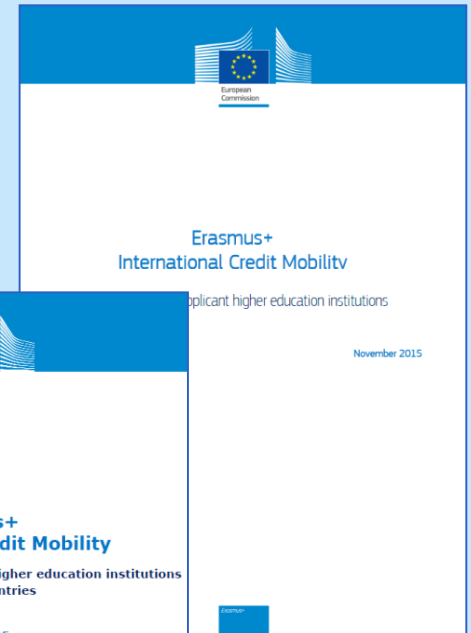
